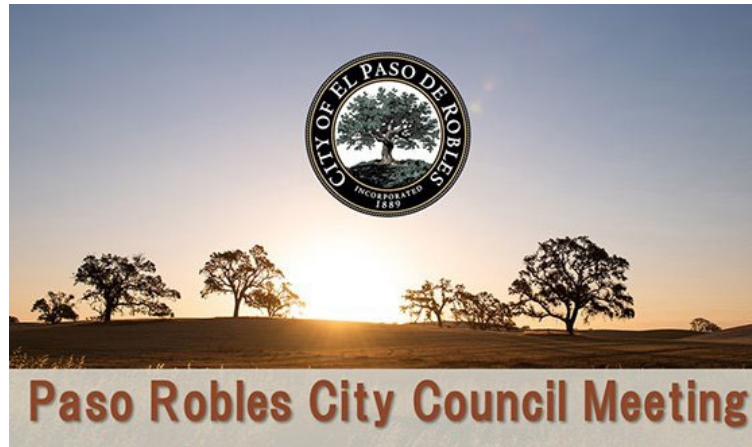

### **City Council Meeting Highlights from May 2, 2023**

At its May 2, 2023 meeting, Paso Robles City Council did the following:

Read proclamations for Public Service Recognition Week, National Foster Care Month and National Travel and Tourism Week and California Tourism Month.

Received the Capital Projects Report, reviewing City construction projects that have been completed or are currently in process.

Received a Community Development Update, reviewing the various private development projects and City infrastructure and traffic circulation projects that are under construction, entitled or in the pipeline.

Held a Public Hearing to annex three parcels into Community Facilities District No. 2005-1 between Creston Road and Union Road.

Adopted the North County Broadband Strategic Plan, which will guide the City, in partnership with the City of Atascadero, in leading the county in broadband infrastructure to allow more residents and businesses access to better, less expensive and more reliable internet access.

Adopted a new Airport Leasing Policy and Leasing Strategy that establishes equitable and consistent terms to support future Airport operations and is consistent with state law and FAA guidance. The policy will be reviewed in one year.
