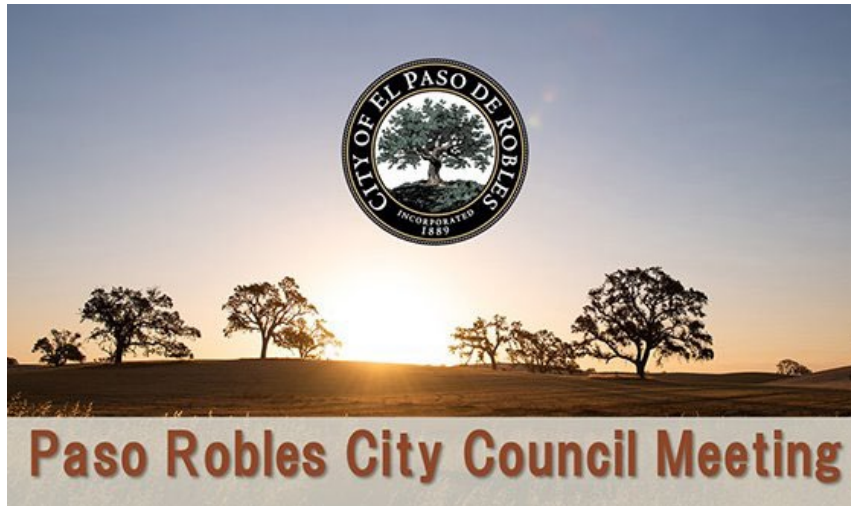

City Council Meeting Highlights from June 6, 2023

At its June 6, 2023 meeting, Paso Robles City Council did the following:

Read a proclamation [in honor of Juneteenth](#).

Received a presentation from [Amtrak on its San Joaquins services](#).

Received the annual [update from the Utilities Department](#), reporting on recently completed projects and activities in the City's Water, Wastewater and Recycled Water divisions

Received the annual [update from the Public Works Department](#) reporting on completed street repairs and upcoming street and infrastructure projects.

Held a Public Hearing for the [annual levy of Landscape & Lighting Maintenance District No. 1 and Drainage Maintenance District 2008-1](#) and approved staff's recommendations for annual levy and service increases or decreases, depending on resident votes in each subarea.

Received a 90-day review of the [Downtown On-Street Parking Program](#) and took action to extend the contract with Flowbird to manage the parking app and kiosk software with no changes to the 2 free hours for parking (after registering your license plate) and \$2 per hour after that. Councilmembers Bausch and Gregory will sit on a limited duration ad hoc committee with support from the Parking Coordinator to discuss the future of downtown parking. Ad hoc findings will be brought back to council by September 2023.

City Council Meeting Highlights from June 20, 2023

At its June 20, 2023 meeting, Paso Robles City Council did the following:

Read a proclamation in honor of [Amateur Radio Week](#).

Received annual updates from the [Community Services Department](#), the [Administrative Services Department](#) and the [City Manager's Office](#).

Council convened as the City of Paso Robles Groundwater Sustainability Agency Board to receive and file a proposed [Statement of Equity](#) that will be included in the next Groundwater Sustainability Plan update. [Councilmember Hamon submitted a draft letter](#) to the Paso Basin Cooperative Committee as an alternative to Supervisor Gibson's draft submittal. No action was required. [Draft Statement](#). [Staff report](#)

Approved a [Weed Abatement resolution](#), confirming the existence of weeds or noxious growth creating a potential fire hazard and ordering their abatement. 31 properties within city limits will have their weed abatement performed by the City. Costs associated with the City ordered work will be recouped via direct invoice or through a special assessment lien on the negligent properties, if necessary. The charges for each of the unabated properties cover the full cost of the abatement, including administrative costs. [Staff report](#)

Held a Public Hearing and approved [Consumer Price Index annual inflationary adjustments, annual position-based adjustments, and amendments to the Comprehensive Fee Schedule for Fiscal Year 2023-24](#). [Staff report](#)

Approved the [Peterbilt Truck Dealership Development Plan](#) and off-site billboard sign Conditional Use Permit for the property located at 2805 Theatre Drive. [Staff report](#)

Received a [mid-budget update](#) and approved Fiscal Year 2023-24 budget amendments, General Fund appropriations limit, and Master Pay Schedule. [Staff report](#)
