Street Tree policies:

1. The above-noted species are suitable (as noted) for planting in narrow planters, parkways, tree wells, medians and open space areas, and are the only trees that will be accepted for planting in City-maintained landscape easements and parkways.
2. While other tree species not included on this list may be used on private property, please note that care should be used in choosing and placing trees so that the root system does not impact City structures or facilities such as sewer lines, curbs and sidewalks, or overhead power lines.
3. Certain tree species are known to have characteristics such as weeping branches, aggressive or invasive roots, or falling fruit and seed pods that cause maintenance problems when placed close to structures and pedestrian pathways. Section 10.04.080 of the Municipal Code places financial responsibility on the property owner for repairs to City facilities caused by trees on private property. The owner is also responsible for maintaining and trimming trees on private property.
4. Consultation with a nursery or landscape professional is recommended to determine if the selected tree species is appropriate for the desired location.
5. A deep root control barrier is required for any tree placed within six feet of City curb or sidewalk, and is recommended for trees placed in parking lot planters.
6. See the attached Street Tree Planting diagram for the City's installation requirements.

Definitions:

Accent – a tree species most appropriate to provide aesthetic beauty in a specified and limited area; may not be appropriate for general planting.

Median – generally, a planted area 10' wide or wider placed between roadway travel lanes. Medians vary in width and all proposed trees require approval by a City official prior to installation. If the median is 10' or less in width, tree species listed for Parkway /Tree Well apply. Use only standard specimen trees with a minimum height of 8 ft. and minimum 1" caliper trunk.


Park – an area of land, usually in a largely natural state, for the enjoyment of City residents, having facilities for rest and recreation.

Parkway / Tree Well – a planted area less than 10' wide between curb and gutter and sidewalk. These are typically trees planted to beautify sidewalk areas and create a tree-lined street. Use only standard specimen trees with a minimum height of 8 ft. and minimum 1" caliper trunk.

Open Space – undeveloped land (has no buildings or structures) that is accessible to the public. Open Space can include green space (land that is partly or completely covered with grass, trees, shrubs or other vegetation).
