

# *Amaryllis belladonna*

Common Name: Naked Lady

Family: Amaryllidaceae

Light: Full sun.

Characteristics of plant: Foliage is 1' tall, 2' wide. Straplike leaves appear in fall and winter and die back by summer. After 6 weeks, 2'-3' stalks with trumpet-shaped pink flowers appear.

Water needs: None.

Special Features: All parts are poisonous if ingested.

# *Crocosmia crocosmiiflora*

Common Name: Montbretia

Family: Iridaceae

Light: Some shade in hottest climates.

Characteristics of plant: Clumps of sword-like leaves to 3' tall. Flowers in yellow, orange or red appear on branched stems in summer.

Water needs: Regular water during growth and bloom.

# Narcissus

Common Name: Daffodil  
Family: Amaryllidaceae  
Light: Full sun to light shade.  
Characteristics of plant: Growth varies with species. Long narrow leaves appear in spring with flowers of yellow, white or combinations thereof appearing shortly after leaves. Leaves die back in summer.  
Water needs: Regular water during growth and bloom.  
Special Features: Good for naturalizing. Gopher resistant.

# Watsonia

Common Name: Watsonia  
Family: Iridaceae  
Light: Full sun.  
Characteristics of plant: Clumps of sword-like foliage to 2 1/2' tall. Spikes of trumpet-like flowers in white, pink or red.  
Water needs: Regular water during growth and bloom.

# *Zephyranthes candida*

Common Name: Zephyr Flower  
Family: Amaryllidaceae  
Light: Full sun or partial shade.  
Characteristics of plant: 1' tall clumps of bright green, grassy leaves are evergreen in warmer areas. White 2" flowers can appear several times during the year if plants are given a short dry spell after each bloom.  
Water needs: Regular water during growth and bloom.
