Common Name: Carolina Jessamine

Family: Loganiaceae

Light: Full sun or partial shade.

Characteristics of plant: Evergreen vine with moderate growth to 20' tall. Shiny green leaves. Yellow tubular flowers bloom in late winter and early spring.

Water needs: Regular supplemental water.

Special Features: All parts are poisonous if ingested.

Polygonum (Fallopia) aubertii

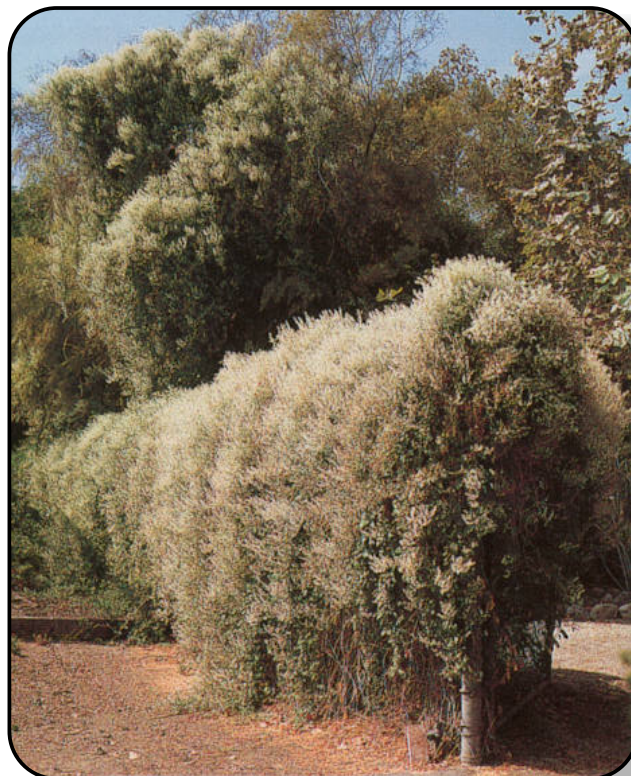

Common Name: Silver Lace Vine

Family: Polygonaceae

Light: Full sun.

Characteristics of plant: Deciduous vine is a vigorous grower to 40'.

Heart-shaped, glossy green leaves. Covered with masses of white flowers from spring to fall.

Water needs: Little to regular supplemental water.

Rosa banksiae

Common Name: Lady Banks' Rose
Family: Rosaceae
Light: Full sun.
Characteristics of plant: Evergreen climbing vine is a vigorous grower to 20' tall. Almost thornless, with large clusters of yellow or white flowers which bloom early to late spring.
Water needs: Regular water.
Special Features: Aphid resistant and almost immune to disease.

Rosa 'Cecile Brunner'

Common Name: Cecile Brunner Rose
Family: Rosaceae
Light: Full sun.
Characteristics of plant: Evergreen to deciduous rose can reach 20' tall. Primary flush of blooms in spring, sporadic blooming for the rest of the season. Smallish blooms are pink and scented.
Water needs: Regular water.

Wisteria sinensis

Common Name: Chinese Wisteria
Family: Fabaceae
Light: Full sun or partial shade.
Characteristics of plant: Very vigorous deciduous vine can become very large and woody. Leaves are divided into leaflets. Flowers are violet-blue or white, in long clusters, and bloom before leafout.
Water needs: Little to moderate supplemental water.
Special Features: Will bloom in considerable shade.
