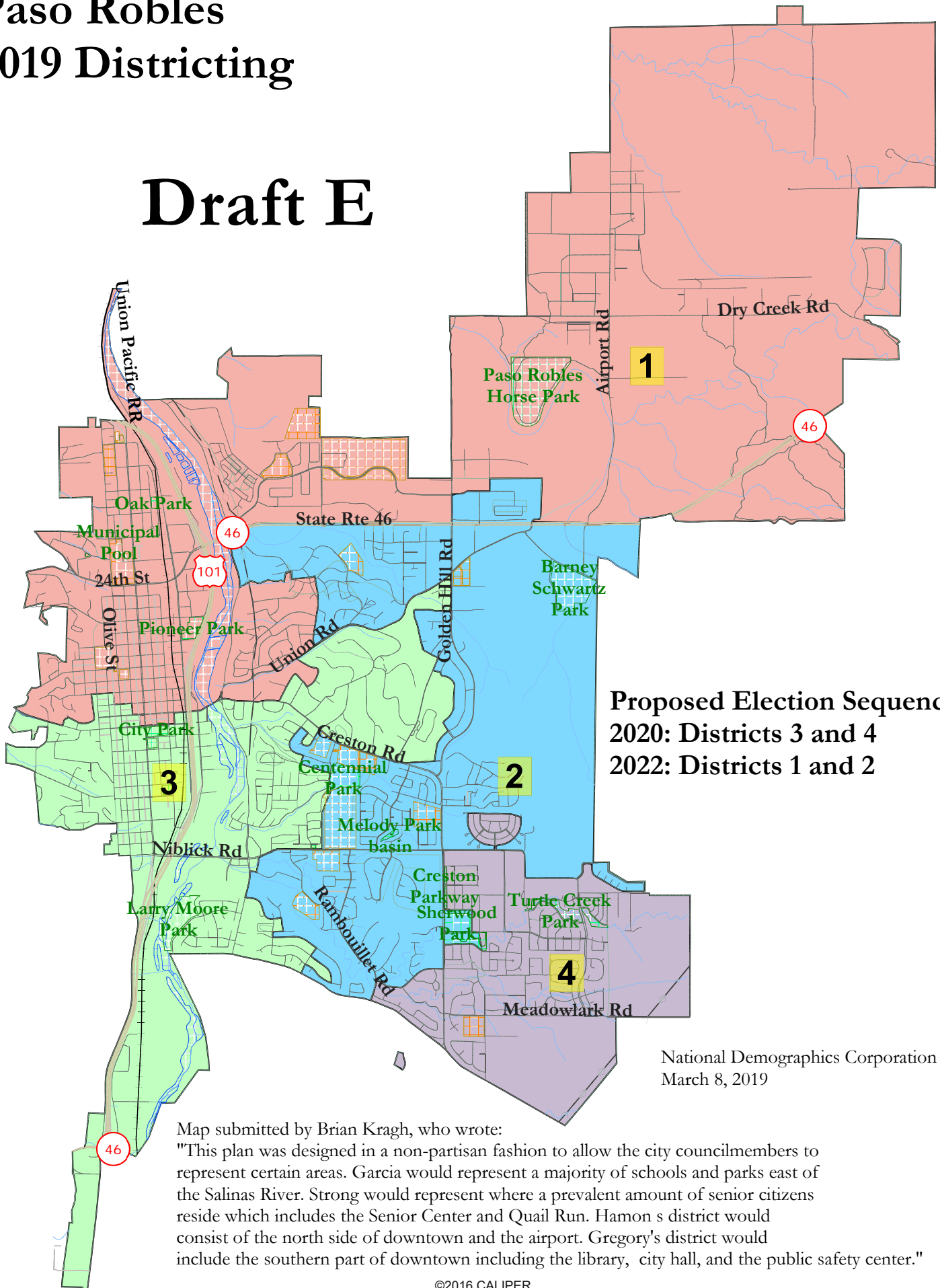


# Paso Robles 2019 Districting
