1. Senior parking permit pilot is from April 1, 2020 to September 30, 2020. All permit fees and charges are non-refundable and fees will not be prorated for partial periods.
2. All permit applications must be accompanied by a copy of a valid driver's license for permit applicants 65 years of age or over at the time of purchase.
3. Permits are only valid for the identified permit holder and their specified vehicle. Any other use of the permit is not authorized to park without following established on street parking procedures.
4. Permit holders can park in public parking spaces in the downtown parking management area, excluding short term and loading zone spaces.
5. Permit applications will be processed within 7 days of receipt of completed application and payment.

## Terms of Use

By signing below you agree to be bound by the following terms and conditions.

## General Terms & Conditions

Permits are only valid for the specified area for which they are designated. Permits remain the property of the City of Paso Robles.

You may not assign or transfer your permit use under the parking permit agreement or allow any other party to utilize your parking permit, unless agreed to in writing by the City of Paso Robles.

When parking in a paid parking space, at all times a valid license plate must be visibly displayed on the vehicle. Only front-end parking is allowed in all paid parking spaces. Failure to do so will be considered a breach and, in addition to any other remedies available to the City of Paso Robles, may result in a violation notice being issued and your vehicle may be towed or booted.

Any misuse of a permit will be considered a breach of the parking permit. Misuse includes, but is not limited to, allowing any third party to use a permit. If you are in breach of the terms and conditions, the City of Paso Robles may, without notice, suspend parking privileges; terminate the parking permit agreement; and/or, to the extent permitted by applicable law, tow or boot the vehicle at your expense.

The parking of unlicensed or uninsured vehicles, the general storage of vehicles, and the repair or maintenance of vehicles, including car washing, is prohibited. Further, the parking of vehicles that in the opinion of the City of Paso Robles pose any kind of hazard or have hazardous contents is also prohibited. Vehicles must not be parked in such a way as to block traffic lanes or violate any laws or regulations.

Permit holders must abide by all staff instructions, parking space designations, traffic signs, fire lanes, height restrictions, official notices, and other facility markings. Permit holders can park in public parking spaces in the downtown parking management area, excluding short term and loading zone spaces.

All space is available on a first-come, first-serve basis at the sole discretion of the City of Paso Robles. A parking space is not guaranteed.

The City of Paso Robles may terminate this agreement with thirty (30) days notice. Permit holder may terminate this agreement with thirty (30) days notice. Termination by permit holder shall only be effective following the notice period. Permit holder agrees that the City of Paso Robles will not provide refunds or a prorated fee for any partial months.

These terms and conditions are subject to change by the City of Paso Robles without notice. In the event the City of Paso Robles makes any changes to these terms and conditions, they will post the changes on the city website. Please check periodically to review the terms and conditions.

The City of Paso Robles does not assign a definite space to permit holder, but specifically reserves the right to designate, from time to time, the space to be used by the permit holder. Fees are due regardless of whether permit holder uses the space or not.

### Liability Notice

The City of Paso Robles is not responsible for loss or damage to any vehicle, the vehicle contents, or personal injury as a result of fire, theft, or ordinary or gross negligence; nor are they responsible for personal property left in the vehicle, nor for any damage or injury sustained through faulty vehicle equipment.

The permit holder accepts responsibility for damages caused by any vehicle accessing the parking locations using their permit. The permit holder agrees to hold harmless the City of Paso Robles for any damage and/or personal injury claims arising from the permit holder and/or additional users' use of the parking locations.

### Fees and Charges

All fees and charges are non-refundable and no fees will be pro-rated for partial periods. Fees and charges are subject to change without notice by the City of Paso Robles.

Permit holder is responsible for all applicable taxes.

To the extent permitted by applicable law, the City of Paso Robles reserves the right to tow or boot, at the owner's expense, any vehicle parked without the proper permit or authorized parking session.
