Completing the 2020 Census plays a vital role in shaping our communities, so please, take a few minutes to complete your survey today.

Across the nation people are being told to “shelter-in-place” due to COVID-19. Fortunately the 2020 Census is now filled out over the phone or online.

Be Counted - It's Easy

Why should I fill out the Census?

California receives federal funding based on information collected through the census that creates jobs, affordable housing, roads, hospitals, and much more. You're a fundamental part of the process, because you reflect the needs of your community.

Where do I go online or what number do I call to complete my survey?

You can visit: <http://my2020census.gov> or call **844-330-2020**.

All you need is your unique Census ID that came in the mail, or if you didn't receive one, or don't want to wait, you can use your physical address instead of a Census ID. (Some select households will be mailed a paper survey to fill out and return via the mail.)

How long is the survey?

The survey is only 9 questions long and takes only 10 minutes to fill out.

What else should I know about the 2020 Census?

It will not ask you for: your social security number, your citizenship status, bank account information, or for payments or donations, and all collected information is confidential.

I don't speak or read English well, how can I get assistance with filling out the survey in my language?

There are phone lines in 13 languages and online forms in 59 languages.
