



## Frequently Asked Questions Golden & Union Intersection Closure



**Q1 Why is the intersection closed completely?**

**A1** Saves time and money, avoids having multiple changing closures.

**Q2 Why are we building a roundabout?**

**A2** To accommodate future growth and avoid having to buy land to reconfigure the 4-way stop to install a traffic signal.

**Q3 How long will it be closed?**

**A3** Approximately 9-10 months.

**Q4 Are all of the businesses around that intersection open?**

**A4** Yes, all businesses will remain open during construction. PLEASE do not use Bronco Burger driveway to cut through.

**Q5 What is the best way to get to the Lowe's center from Union?**

**A5** From the south end of town, go north on Golden Hill, right on Ardmore, left on Union, right on Golden Hill to traffic signal at Hwy 46. (PLEASE do not use driveways at the medical plaza)

If you live north of Union, go toward downtown on Union, right on North River, right on River Oaks, past Cuesta College to Golden Hill.

**Q6 What's the best way to Paso Robles High School from Jardine Road/east of town?**

**A6** Union to Ardmore to Golden Hill to Creston to Niblick

or

46E to Riverside to 13<sup>th</sup> to River Rd to Niblick

**Q7 What's the best way to get downtown from east of town?**

**A7** Union to Golden Hill, left on 46E to Spring.

**Q8 What's the best way to Paso Robles High School from River Oaks?**

**A8** River Oaks to North River to Niblick

**Q9 What's the best way to get to Creston Road from 24<sup>th</sup>/101?**

**A9** 46E to Union (by Barney Schwartz Park) to Ardmore to Golden Hill to Creston

**Q10 When was the decision made to build a roundabout at that location?**

**A10** In 2011, when the City Council adopted the Circulation Element to help accommodate future growth.
